CLEANSING STATEMENT

Ardiden Limited (ASX: ADV – the “Company” or “Ardiden”) has issued and allotted 177,692,308 ordinary shares under Listing Rule 7.1 to Sophisticated Investors as part of the Placement as announced on 8 May 2018. This completes tranche 2 of the \$6.11m capital raise managed by Canaccord Genuity (Australia) Pty Ltd. The Company has also issued and allotted 23,500,000 shares to Canaccord Genuity Australia Pty Ltd as payment of the underwriting and management fees for the capital raising and 37,500,000 options with varying terms as payment of the ongoing corporate advisory fees. The relevant Appendix 3B is attached to this announcement.

Secondary Trading Exemption:

The Act restricts the on-sale of securities issued without disclosure, unless the sale is exempt under Section 708 or 708A. By the Company giving this notice, a sale of the Securities noted above will fall within the exemption in section 708A(5) of the Act.
