Clarification of 23 February 2017 Announcement

DroneShield Ltd (ASX:DRO) (“DroneShield” or the “Company”) would like to provide further information in relation to its announcement of 23 February 2017 (the “23 February Announcement”) in relation to a sale of a DroneGun.

As stated in the 23 February Announcement, the sale was made to the Company’s distributor, Zariba Security, who the Company understands then on-sold the product to a Middle Eastern country’s Ministry of Defence. Consistent with its strategy of relying on its distributors, the Company has no contractual relationship with the distributor’s end customer.

The Company notes that while the price for the DroneGun has been received from the distributor at the full carded rate, the fact that the sale involved only one test unit means that the revenue from this sale is not material. DroneShield anticipates earning additional revenue in relation to this sale only if the distributor’s customer places an order with the distributor (and the distributor places an order with the Company) for additional DroneGuns (or drone detection products) following the testing of the trial unit.
