For the year ended 30 June 2017, Aconex Group revenue grew 31% to \$161.2m from \$123.4m in 2016. The uplift was principally driven by the Conject acquisition and international revenue growth. Underlying growth in 2017 (ex. Conject) was 16% on a constant currency basis.

The Aconex Group recorded EBITDA from core operations of \$15.0m for the year ended 30 June 2017, a \$1.4m uplift on the prior corresponding period. The improvement in EBITDA reflects the Group's growing revenue base.
