As announced on 6 April 2016 the company has entered into an additional Convertible Note arrangement to provide further working capital as envisaged in the announcement dated 22 February 2016. The 14,545,455 shares have been issued pursuant to part conversion of the April 2017 unsecured convertible note for a face value of \$160,000.

(c) No underwriting arrangements were applicable to the LR 7.1A issue.

(d) No fees or other costs were applicable to the LR 7.1A issue.

KBL Mining is an Australian resource Company listed on the ASX (KBL and KBLGA) with a focus on producing precious and base metals. KBL's main assets include the Mineral Hill copper-gold-silver-lead-zinc mine near Condobolin in New South Wales and Sorby Hills lead-silver-zinc project in Western Australia. The Company has been operating the refurbished processing plant at Mineral Hill since October 2011 to produce copper-gold concentrates and in 2013 commenced producing a separate lead-silver concentrate. Sorby Hills (KBL holds 75% with Henan Yuguang Gold & Lead Co. Ltd (HYG&L) holding 25%) is a large near surface undeveloped silver-lead deposit close to port infrastructure and a short distance from Asian markets. A PFS for stage 1 of the project (400,000tpa open cut ore processed) was released on 6 December 2012. Environmental approvals for stage 1 were granted in 2014.
